Our Process

01

BOOK A DISCOVERY CALL

Schedule a complementary 20-minute discovery call to explore your goals, review your space, and ensure we are aligned before moving forward.

02

BOOK A SESSION OR PACKAGE

Following the discovery call, you may choose to move forward with single sessions or a multi-session package based on your needs and project scope.

03

SCHEDULING

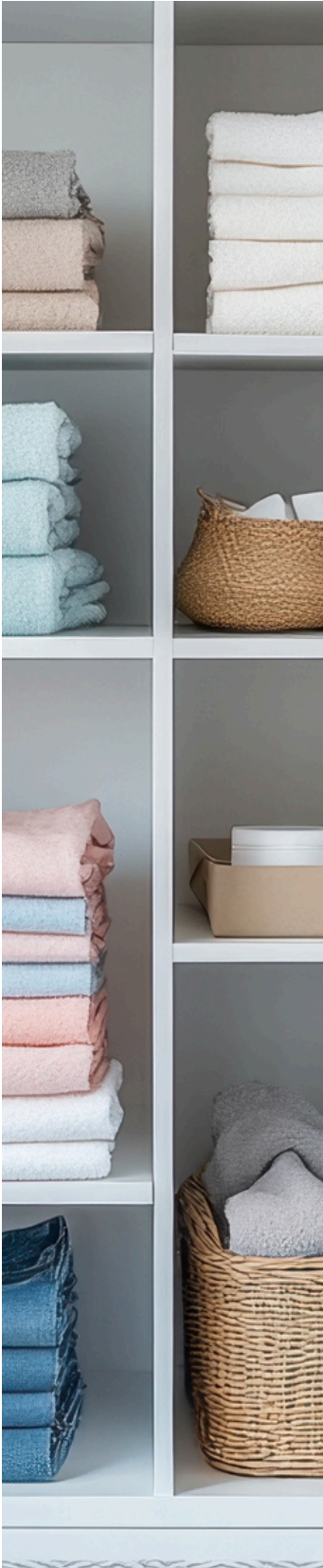
A 50 percent deposit is required to confirm scheduling. Cancellations within 48 hours of a scheduled session will incur a 50 percent service charge for that day. The remaining balance is due upon completion of each scheduled session.

04

PROJECT PHASE

Once your dates are secured, your project officially begins, moving into our project phase.





Project Phase Timeline

01

SORT & EDIT

This foundational phase focuses on decluttering and decision-making. Your presence is required as we sort items together at a pace that's manageable for you, clarifying what stays and identifying items for donation or release with care and intention.

02

MEASURE, DESIGN, PRODUCT SELECTION

After decluttering, measurements are taken as needed. Functional layouts are assessed, and organizing products are selected to support flow, use, and sustainability within your space.

03

ORGANIZING & PLACEMENT

This is the hands-on implementation phase. At this stage, you're welcome to step away while we work. Products are placed, systems are built, and your home is organized with intention to support your daily routines and flow. Labeling is completed at the end, once everything has found its home.

04

REFINE

Organization evolves through use. After living with the systems for a period of time, refinement sessions allow space to identify what's working, what isn't, and where adjustments may be needed. Together, we fine tune and support the systems so they feel natural, functional, and sustainable.

Sessions & Rates

Sessions are scheduled in two-hour increments with an option to book up to three sessions per day when available. Package pricing options are made available after your discovery call to ensure clarity and alignment.

For larger spaces or high-volume projects, enhanced sessions with two organizers are available. A second organizer may be added at a rate of \$70 per hour to provide additional support and momentum.

Downsizing & Unpacking



Downsizing and unpacking often take place during seasons of transition. A move. A life change. A desire to simplify and carry less forward. Downsizing focuses on reducing what you manage in your home. Together, we sort through belongings and make intentional decisions about what will remain and what you're ready to release. The process is thoughtful and paced with care, allowing room for both clarity and reflection.

Unpacking begins once you are in your new home. Belongings are placed with intention using what you already own. Furniture, décor, and personal items are arranged with attention to flow, balance, and visual cohesion. When needed, guidance is offered on product options that can enhance function and flow. The work is collaborative and structured. The goal is a home that feels settled and supportive of your next chapter.

Senior Move Management

YOUR INVESTMENT

Projects begin at \$3,000 for a studio or one-bedroom move within 50 miles.

Pricing varies based on scope, volume, and distance.

Later-life transitions often carry both physical and emotional weight. Leaving a longtime home can feel overwhelming for seniors and their families, especially when decisions are tied to memory and meaning.

This deep work supports older adults as they transition into a new residence with care and dignity. Together, we sort through personal belongings and make thoughtful decisions about what moves forward, what may be donated or passed on, and what is ready to be released. Support may include coordination with estate sale professionals when appropriate.

Once in the new home, familiar items are thoughtfully arranged to create comfort, flow, and a sense of continuity. Furniture, artwork, and meaningful pieces are placed with intention, with guidance provided when additional items may support daily living or safety. Trash and donation items are removed and repurposed when possible, up to vehicle capacity per session.

FAQ's

Do I need to clean before you arrive?

No. This work begins exactly where you are. For safety reasons, any known hazards such as mold, pest activity, or other conditions requiring protective equipment must be disclosed in advance so appropriate support can be arranged before our organizing work begins.

Will you make me get rid of things? What happens to the items I let go of?

Never. You remain in control of all decisions. I believe in sustainability and giving back. Whenever possible, I donate items to local ministries and non-profits in need rather than large thrift corporations. I also repurpose and rehome pieces to ensure they find new life and bring joy to someone else.

Should I buy bins or products before we start? Do you shop for products?

I recommend that you **don't buy anything ahead of time**. More containers can sometimes create more clutter. I believe in a less-is-more approach and only suggest products when I know they'll truly enhance your space's function and flow. Yes. With your approval, I can source and recommend products aligned with your budget, values, and style.

How long do projects usually take?

Every home is different. Timelines depend on the volume of items, your decision-making pace, and the scope of work in relation to your desired outcome. Most projects unfold over one to three full-day sessions (6 hours each). Our goal is to find a rhythm that feels manageable and fits your priorities.

Do you work with ADHD, neurodivergent, or hoarding clients?

Yes. My approach is gentle, nonjudgmental, and centered on how you naturally think and live. We move at your pace, and collaborate to implement systems and layouts that feel supportive and easier to maintain long after our sessions end.
